2013 Miro Cellars Zinfandel Mancini Vineyard

The delicious 2013 Zinfandel Mancini Vineyard comes from century-old vines that provide the essence of wild berry fruit, pepper, spice and plenty of black cherry and black raspberry. This is beautifully opulent, lush, sexy and classic Zinfandel. Drink it over the next 4-5 years.

2013 Miro Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon Silverwood Vineyard

The 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon Silverwood Vineyard comes from Pine Mountain, in this case a vineyard at a 2,200-foot elevation. The color is deep ruby/purple and the wine offers plenty of blackberry and cassis, a nice touch of oak and licorice. It is full-bodied, rich, concentrated and impressive. Drink it over the next 10-15 years.
